

**UNILATERAL TERMINATION OF AGREEMENT BETWEEN SEMINOLE COUNTY  
AND RESCUE OUTREACH MISSION OF CENTRAL FLORIDA, INC.  
FOR AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT FUNDING**

**THIS UNILATERAL TERMINATION OF AGREEMENT** is made and entered into this \_\_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_\_, 2021, by and between **RESCUE OUTREACH MISSION OF CENTRAL FLORIDA, INC.**, whose address is 1701 Historic Goldsboro Boulevard, Sanford, Florida 32771, in this Unilateral Termination of Agreement referred to as “SUBRECIPIENT,” and **SEMINOLE COUNTY**, a charter county and political subdivision of the State of Florida, whose address is Seminole County Services Building, 1101 E. 1<sup>st</sup> Street, Sanford, Florida 32771, in this Unilateral Termination of Agreement referred to as “COUNTY.”

**W I T N E S S E T H:**

**WHEREAS**, on July 24, 2021, COUNTY entered into an agreement with SUBRECIPIENT, which identified sources of funding that may be available to SUBRECIPIENT contingent on SUBRECIPIENT meeting the criteria specified in the agreement; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 4(a) of the July 24, 2021 agreement contemplates each funding allocation requiring the execution of separate funding agreements by SUBRECIPIENT; and

**WHEREAS**, the American Rescue Plan Act (“ARPA”) and U.S. Department of Treasury (“Treasury”) guidance allows COUNTY to provide non-profits financial assistance to respond to the public health emergency or its negative economic impacts; and

**WHEREAS**, SUBRECIPIENT is a non-profit essential and/or a supportive resource in Seminole County, providing assistance to local citizens in reducing homelessness and providing assistance to become self-sufficient; and

**WHEREAS**, SUBRECIPIENT and the constituencies it serves have encountered negative economic impacts due to the COVID-19 public health emergency; and

**WHEREAS**, as contemplated by the July 24, 2021 agreement, on September 22, 2021, COUNTY and SUBRECIPIENT entered into an agreement (“Agreement”) for COUNTY to provide American Rescue Plan Act (“ARPA”) funding to SUBRECIPIENT for eligible expenditures under the ARPA and Treasury guidance, as further specified in the Agreement; and

**WHEREAS**, other non-ARPA related sources of funding contemplated by the July 24, 2021 agreement have either been provided to SUBRECIPIENT or are in the process of being provided to SUBRECIPIENT pursuant to separate funding agreements containing terms and conditions required by the U.S. Housing and Urban Development; and

**WHEREAS**, SUBRECIPIENT has requested and COUNTY has agreed, to provide additional ARPA funding to SUBRECIPIENT; and



**WHEREAS**, it is in the best interest of the COUNTY to have one agreement clearly specifying all of the terms and conditions required of SUBRECIPIENT to receive ARPA funding;

**WHEREAS**, Section 10(b) of the Agreement allows COUNTY to terminate the Agreement immediately for convenience; and

**WHEREAS**, by way of this Unilateral Termination of Agreement, COUNTY is hereby terminating the Agreement immediately; and

**WHEREAS**, COUNTY will provide SUBRECIPIENT a new agreement for execution incorporating many of the terms and conditions from previous agreements referenced herein, as well as additional terms and conditions,

**NOW, THEREFORE,**

1. The foregoing recitals are true and correct and form a material part of this Unilateral Termination of Agreement.

2. The Agreement is hereby terminated.

3. COUNTY does not owe SUBRECIPIENT any payment under the Agreement.

**IN WITNESS WHEREOF,** the parties have made and executed this Unilateral Termination of Agreement for the purposes stated above.
