An ordinance amending Seminole County Code: Chapter 20, "Animals and Fowl"; Chapter 72, "Emergency Management"; to remove animal license / tag program.

**DESCRIBE THE DIRECT ECONOMIC IMPACT OF THE PROJECT/ PROPOSAL UPON THE OPERATION OF THE COUNTY:**

There is no direct economic impact on current operations of the County. The fees for animal license/tag is \$ 5 or \$ 25 based on animal neuter/spay. The operational costs for the providing the program is consistent with this income. The revenues in 2021 is \$ 88,489. The cost for mailing, managing volunteers, and coordinating these activities is over this.
